1. Defendants' Motion to Strike Gerald Casenave, Ph.D. is **Denied**.
2. Defendants' Motion to Strike Andrew Irwin is **Denied**.
3. Defendants' Motion to Limit Testimony is **Granted** as to any expert opinions to be offered by Officers Bean and Roland. As to Trooper Druessedow, the ruling does not operate to prevent testimony as to minimum speed as set forth in the motion.
4. Defendants' remaining objections related to items requested from Shaillette Abbott are denied to the extent that she possesses any of the items requested.
